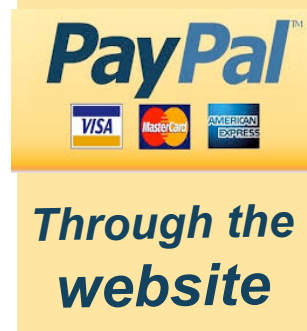

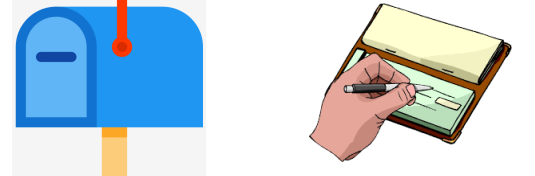

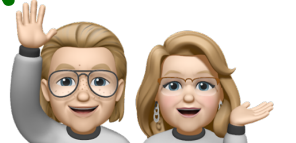

JOY IN THE JOURNEY



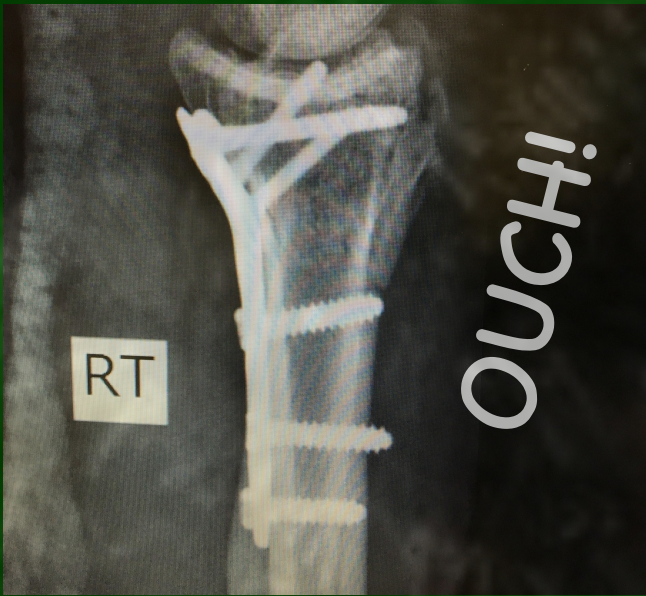
Volunteered with our local church and Salvation Army with food distribution for COVID and fire relief
